Patients are cared for in in-patient units or receive care in the community through their local homecare service. Hospice care allows people to live as actively as possible until death. It is about treating someone as a living person and not a dying patient. It is also about providing a vital support system for their relatives and loved ones.

The voluntary hospice movement is an all-island network of local fundraising groups which raise funds throughout the year to ensure that patients and their families receive the appropriate care and support they need at a time when they are most vulnerable.

LOCAL HOSPICE

Perfect preparation tips from The Bewley's Barista Academy

Cafetiere / Plunger Preparation

- 1 Heat the cafetiere using boiling water.
- 2 Empty water and add one heaped dessertspoon per cup.
- 3 Pour in water that's just off the boil.
- 4 Stir well and let coffee stand for three minutes before plunging slowly.
- 5 Serve and savour.

Golden Rules

- 1 Coffee should be stored in a cool, dark place.
- 2 Fresh ground coffee should never be exposed to air. Store in an airtight container or seal bag accordingly after use.
- 3 Portion correctly for optimum flavour. Bewley's suggest using 1 dessert spoon of freshly ground coffee per average sized cup.
- 4 Never use water just off the boil to prepare fresh ground coffee. Boiling water spoils the flavour of the coffee. The best brewing temperature for coffee lies between 91-96 °C.
